This iconic circuit – steeped in motorsport history – has been a staple of the FIA WEC calendar since the series' inception, and the 7km-long 'Ardennes rollercoaster' invariably throws up drama, spills and surprises.

Indeed, with four Belgian drivers entered across the Hypercar and LMGT3 categories, hopes are high for home soil success.

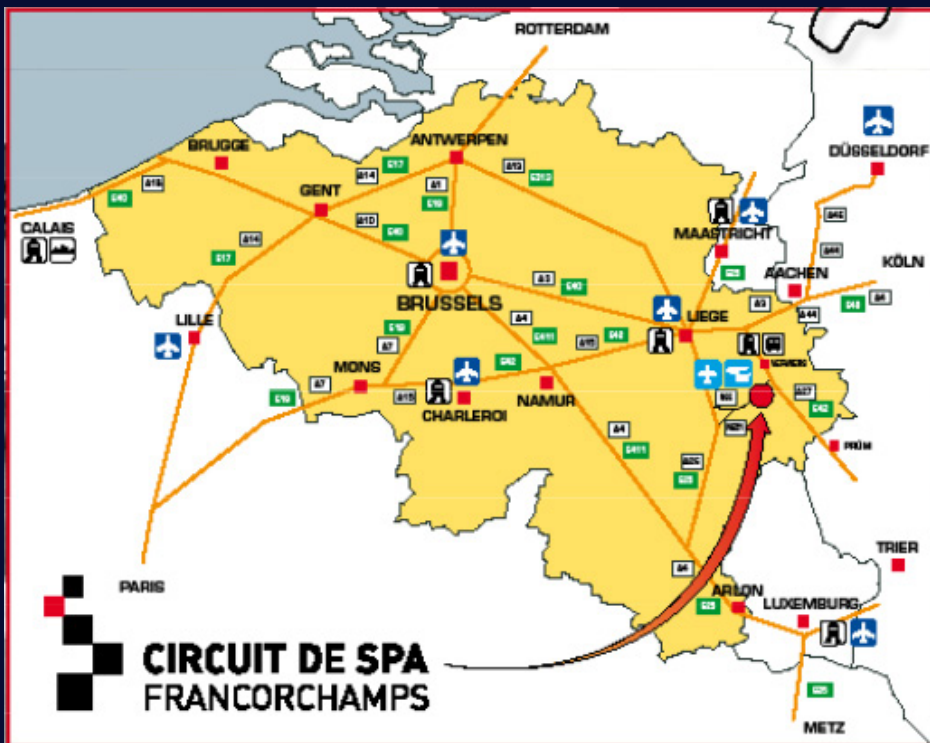

## IMPORTANT\*\*

### THERE WILL BE NO PHYSICAL PHOTO BRIEFING ON-SITE

All photographers and TV crews must attend a 30-minute online photo briefing. Anyone who joins more than 10 minutes late or does not attend at least 20 minutes of the briefing will not be eligible to receive a tabard. Journalists and team press officers are not required to read the photo briefing document this season unless they intend to apply for track or pitlane access.

Several ZOOM sessions will be organized by FIA Media Delegate, Piotr MAGDZIARZ. The link and schedule will be sent to all photographers and TV crews in advance and can also be found below.

During the briefing, an online form must be completed to collect your tabard from the media centre. This form will serve as proof that you have attended the briefing. It also includes a deposit, which will only be cashed if the tabard is lost or damaged. Tabards must be returned immediately after the podium ceremony to the media centre.

Any social media activity involving an external party should obtain the team / driver's permission in advance.

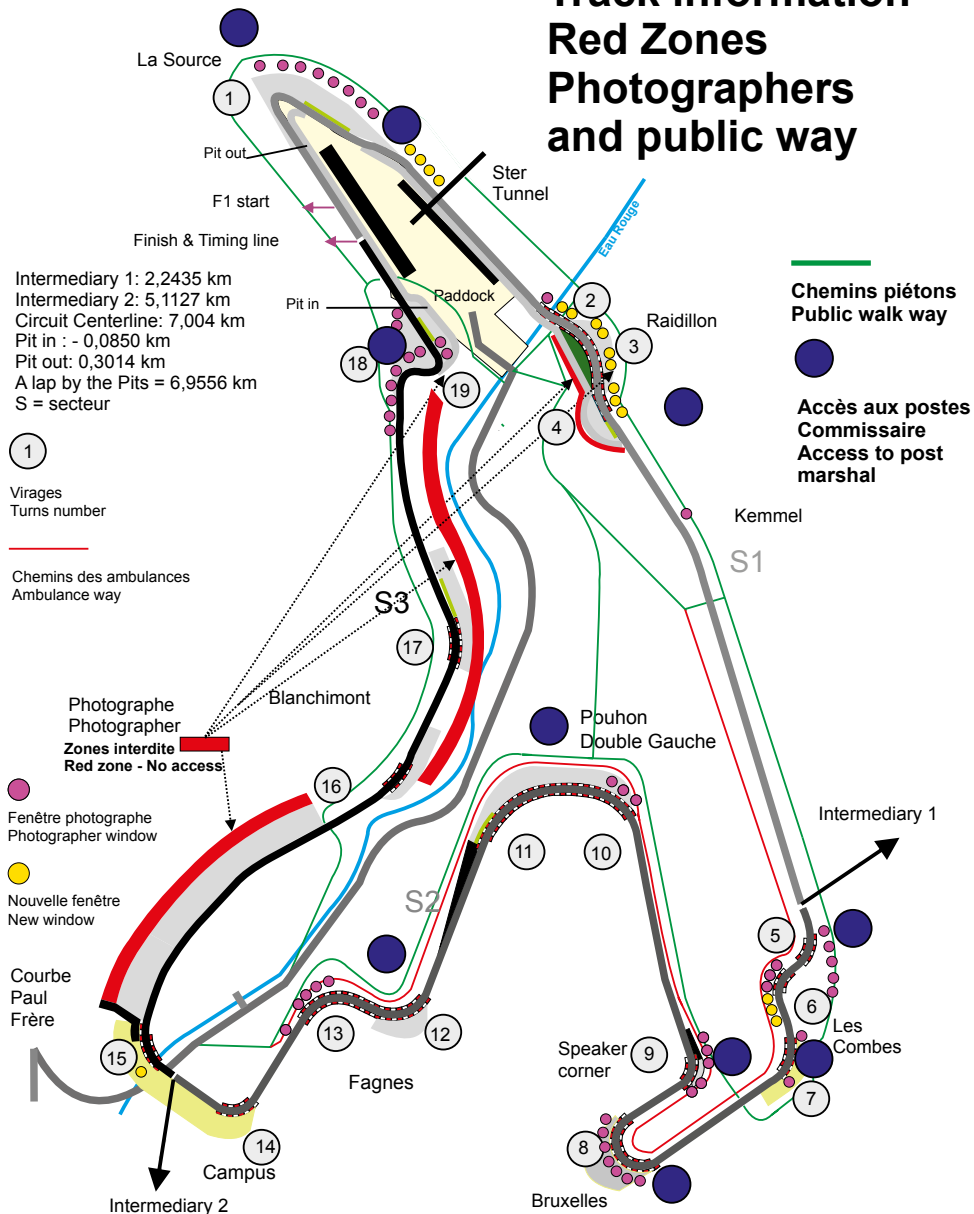
