HOW TO GET TO THE CIRCUIT



Car and Taxi

The circuit is about 18km from the city centre, which is a 1-hour drive. Traffic in São Paulo is normally heavy, so please allow plenty of time for commuting between locations. If you're not hiring a car, a taxi is the easiest way to get to the track.



Train

Autódromo Station (on Line 9 – Esmeralda / Osasco-Grajaú) is located approximately a 10-15-minute walk away from the circuit.

ACCREDITATION



Everyone must go to the accreditation centre, even if you already have your season pass. The 2025 FIA WEC Individual Acknowledgment form must be completed online and submitted before going to the accreditation centre.

All passes must be collected during the opening times of the Accreditation Centre. If it's not possible for you to do this, please contact the WEC Media Centre Manager, Oriane Launay.

Passes must be requested by the person to whom they are issued. You cannot collect the pass for another person. Please do not ask as it will not be permitted.

You will need to present your accreditation, alongside proof of identity (Passport, Press Card or Driving Licence) at the São Paulo Accreditation Centre on your arrival.

IF YOU NEED AN EVENT CAR PASS, PLEASE REMEMBER TO ASK FOR ONE WHEN YOU SIGN ON.

THERE WILL BE NO PHYSICAL PHOTO BRIEFING ON-SITE

All photographers and TV crews must attend a 30-minute online photo briefing. Anyone who joins more than 10 minutes late or does not attend at least 20 minutes of the briefing will not be eligible to receive a tabard. Journalists and team press officers are not required to read the photo briefing document this season unless they intend to apply for track or pitlane access.

Several ZOOM sessions will be organized by FIA Media Delegate, Piotr MAGDZIARZ. The link and schedule will be sent to all photographers and TV crews in advance and can also be found below.

During the briefing, an online form must be completed to collect your tabard from the media centre. This form will serve as proof that you have attended the briefing. It also includes a deposit, which will only be cashed if the tabard is lost or damaged. Tabards must be returned immediately after the podium ceremony to the media centre.

TO BE NOTED



MEDIA INFORMATION



WORKING IN THE PITLANE

Pitlane access is strictly limited and is granted to photographers who need to access the area. All photographers and TV crews working in the pitlane are required to wear a fireproof overall to the standard FIA 8856-2000 or the newer FIA8856-2018 standard and a helmet, such as a cycle helmet. If you don't have these items, you will not be able to access the pitlane during the WEC sessions.

MEDIA CAR PARK

To all members of the media, please ask at the accreditation centre for a car pass when you collect your media pass if you need one.

WEC PRESS CONFERENCES

The pre-event, post-qualifying and post-race press conferences will be held in the press conference room. The press conference will be conducted by the WEC press officer and media will be invited to attend.

CIRCUIT MEDIA SHUTTLES

There are regular media shuttles that run around the circuit perimeter road during the event. The start and finish times for this service will be posted on the notice boards in the media centre.
